HOUSE FILE 69 BY HUNTER

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for an Iowa individual income tax checkoff for
- 2 qualified Iowa zoos, making an appropriation, and providing
- 3 for the Act's implementation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

H.F. 69

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 303.91 Iowa zoo fund.
- An Iowa zoo fund is created in the office of the
- 3 treasurer of state. The fund is composed of moneys
- 4 appropriated or available to and obtained or accepted by the
- 5 treasurer of state for deposit in the fund. The fund shall
- 6 include moneys transferred to the fund as provided in section
- 7 422.12I. All interest earned on moneys in the fund shall be
- 8 credited to and remain in the fund. Section 8.33 does not
- 9 apply to moneys in the fund.
- 10 2. Moneys in the fund that are authorized by the department
- 11 of cultural affairs for expenditure are appropriated, and
- 12 shall be used, to provide grants to qualified zoos located
- 13 in the state. To be qualified to receive a grant from the
- 14 Iowa zoo fund, a zoo must not be used primarily as a research
- 15 institution and must be accredited by the American zoo and
- 16 aquarium association.
- 3. The department may authorize payment of moneys from
- 18 the fund upon approval of an application from a private or
- 19 public organization that maintains and operates a zoo in the
- 20 state. The applicant shall show proof of accreditation by the
- 21 American zoo and aquarium association. The applicant shall
- 22 also indicate the annual attendance at the zoo in the calendar
- 23 year preceding the calendar year in which the application is
- 24 filed with the department.
- 25 4. Moneys distributed from the fund to qualified applicants
- 26 shall be prorated among the qualified applicants in the
- 27 proportion that annual attendance at each zoo that is the
- 28 subject of an application bears to the total annual attendance
- 29 at all zoos for which an application was received and approved
- 30 for funding.
- 31 5. The department shall establish rules relating to the
- 32 application process.
- 33 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 422.12I Income tax checkoff for Iowa
- 34 zoo fund.
- 35 l. A person who files an individual or a joint income tax

- 1 return with the department of revenue under section 422.13 may
- 2 designate one dollar or more to be paid to the Iowa zoo fund as
- 3 created in section 303.91. If the refund due on the return or
- 4 the payment remitted with the return is insufficient to pay the
- 5 additional amount designated by the taxpayer to the Iowa zoo
- 6 fund, the amount designated shall be reduced to the remaining
- 7 amount of refund or the remaining amount remitted with the
- 8 return. The designation of a contribution to the Iowa zoo fund
- 9 under this section is irrevocable.
- 10 2. The director of revenue shall draft the income tax form
- 11 to allow the designation of contributions to the Iowa zoo fund
- 12 on the tax return. The department of revenue, on or before
- 13 January 31, shall transfer the total amount designated on the
- 14 tax return forms due in the preceding calendar year to the
- 15 Iowa zoo fund. However, before a checkoff pursuant to this
- 16 section shall be permitted, all liabilities on the books of the
- 17 department of administrative services and accounts identified
- 18 as owing under section 8A.504 and the political contribution
- 19 allowed under section 68A.601 shall be satisfied.
- 20 3. The department of cultural affairs may authorize payment
- 21 of moneys from the Iowa zoo fund, in accordance with section
- 22 303.91.
- 23 4. The department of revenue shall adopt rules to administer
- 24 this section.
- 25 5. This section is subject to repeal under section 422.12E.
- 26 Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The checkoff created in this Act
- 27 shall be eligible for placement on the individual income tax
- 28 return form pursuant to the provisions of section 422.12E.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill provides that taxpayers filing individual income
- 31 tax returns will be allowed to designate \$1 or more on the
- 32 return to be paid to the Iowa zoo fund. The bill creates the
- 33 Iowa zoo fund in the department of cultural affairs. The
- 34 bill requires the department of revenue to annually remit
- 35 moneys collected from the checkoff to the fund. Moneys in the

- 1 fund shall be used to provide grants to qualified zoos that
- 2 submit an application for funding. To be qualified, a zoo
- 3 must be located in the state, not used primarily for research
- 4 activities, and accredited by the American zoo and aquarium
- 5 association.
- 6 The bill provides for the implementation of the checkoff
- 7 according to Code section 422.12E.
