SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

- 1 A Concurrent Resolution requesting the United States
- 2 Food and Drug Administration to rescind approval of
- 3 ulipristal acetate.
- 4 WHEREAS, the United States food and drug
- 5 administration approved ulipristal acetate, marketed
- 6 in the United States under the brand name "ella", on
- 7 August 13, 2010; and
- 8 WHEREAS, ella was approved as an emergency
- 9 contraceptive for use to reduce the risk of pregnancy
- 10 up to five days after unprotected intercourse or
- 11 contraceptive failure; and
- 12 WHEREAS, even though ella was approved only as an
- 13 emergency contraceptive, it has chemical similarities
- 14 to existing drugs such as mifepristone (RU-486), used
- 15 as abortifacients; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the potential for misuse of ella as an
- 17 abortifacient could result in unintended abortions and
- 18 put women's lives at risk; NOW THEREFORE,
- 19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF
- 20 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the Iowa General
- 21 Assembly requests that the United States food and drug
- 22 administration rescind its approval of ella based upon
- 23 its potential use as an abortifacient rather than for
- 24 its approved purpose as an emergency contraceptive; and
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
- 26 resolution be sent to the office of the commissioner of
- 27 the United States food and drug administration and each
- 28 member of Iowa's congressional delegation.
