A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning the operation of motorcycles equipped with
- 2 detachable stabilizing rear wheels on Iowa roads.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 321.435 Motorcycles equipped with 2 detachable stabilizing wheels.
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a motor vehicle
- 4 that is originally designed as a two-wheeled motorcycle and
- 5 is modified using conversion hardware which allows for the
- 6 attachment and detachment of two stabilizing rear wheels may
- 7 be operated on a highway with the stabilizing wheels attached
- 8 in accordance with the provisions of this chapter applicable
- 9 to motorcycles. A motorcycle shall not be determined to be
- 10 reconstructed based on the sole fact that two stabilizing
- 11 wheels have been added as described in this section.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- 13 This bill authorizes operation of motorcycles equipped with
- 14 detachable stabilizing wheels on the rear of the motorcycle.
- 15 The additional wheels are typically installed using an assembly
- 16 mounted on brackets which are permanently attached to the frame
- 17 of the motorcycle. The assembly containing the wheels can be
- 18 removed from the brackets to convert the motorcycle back to
- 19 two-wheeled operation.
- 20 Under current law, the term "motorcycle" is defined to
- 21 include motor vehicles designed to travel on not more than
- 22 three wheels. The bill does not change that definition,
- 23 but allows a motorcycle designed to travel on two wheels
- 24 but equipped with detachable stabilizing rear wheels to be
- 25 operated on Iowa roads as a motorcycle. The bill states that a
- 26 motorcycle is not considered "reconstructed" solely because of
- 27 the addition of detachable stabilizing rear wheels.
