A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for an Iowa individual income tax checkoff for
- 2 qualified Iowa zoos, making an appropriation, and providing
- 3 for the Act's implementation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 303.91 Iowa zoo fund.

An Iowa zoo fund is created in the state treasury under
 the control of the department of cultural affairs. The fund is
 composed of moneys appropriated or available to and obtained
 or accepted by the treasurer of state for deposit in the fund.
 The fund shall include moneys transferred to the fund as
 provided in section 422.121. All interest earned on moneys in
 the fund shall be credited to and remain in the fund. Section
 8.33 does not apply to moneys in the fund.

10 2. Moneys in the fund that are authorized by the department 11 of cultural affairs for expenditure are appropriated, and 12 shall be used, to provide grants to qualified zoos located 13 in the state. To be qualified to receive a grant from the 14 Iowa zoo fund, a zoo must not be used primarily as a research 15 institution and must be accredited by the American zoo and 16 aquarium association.

17 3. The department may authorize payment of moneys from 18 the fund upon approval of an application from a private or 19 public organization that maintains and operates a zoo in the 20 state. The applicant shall show proof of accreditation by the 21 American zoo and aquarium association. The applicant shall 22 also indicate the annual attendance at the zoo in the calendar 23 year preceding the calendar year in which the application is 24 filed with the department.

4. Moneys distributed from the fund to qualified applicants shall be prorated among the qualified applicants in the proportion that annual attendance at each zoo that is the subject of an application bears to the total annual attendance at all zoos for which an application was received and approved for funding.

1 return with the department of revenue under section 422.13 may 2 designate one dollar or more to be paid to the Iowa zoo fund 3 created in section 303.91. If the refund due on the return or 4 the payment remitted with the return is insufficient to pay the 5 additional amount designated by the taxpayer to the Iowa zoo 6 fund, the amount designated shall be reduced to the remaining 7 amount of refund or the remaining amount remitted with the 8 return. The designation of a contribution to the Iowa zoo fund 9 under this section is irrevocable.

2. The director of revenue shall draft the income tax form 11 to allow the designation of contributions to the Iowa zoo fund 12 on the tax return. The department of revenue, on or before 13 January 31, shall transfer the total amount designated on the 14 tax return forms due in the preceding calendar year to the 15 Iowa zoo fund. However, before a checkoff pursuant to this 16 section shall be permitted, all liabilities on the books of the 17 department of administrative services and accounts identified 18 as owing under section 8A.504 and the political contribution 19 allowed under section 68A.601 shall be satisfied.

3. The department of cultural affairs may authorize payment of moneys from the Iowa zoo fund, in accordance with section 22 303.91.

4. The department of revenue shall adopt rules to administer24 this section.

5. This section is subject to repeal under section 422.12E.
Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The checkoff created in this Act
return form pursuant to the provisions of section 422.12E.
EXPLANATION

This bill provides that taxpayers filing individual income tax returns will be allowed to designate \$1 or more on the return to be paid to the Iowa zoo fund. The bill creates the Iowa zoo fund in the state treasury under the control of the department of cultural affairs. The bill requires the bill requires the department of revenue to annually remit moneys collected from

1 the checkoff to the fund. Moneys in the fund shall be used to 2 provide grants to qualified zoos that submit an application for 3 funding. To be qualified, a zoo must be located in the state, 4 not used primarily for research activities, and accredited by 5 the American zoo and aquarium association.

6 The bill provides for the implementation of the checkoff 7 according to Code section 422.12E, which allows no more than 8 four checkoffs on the individual tax return form and provides 9 for the automatic repeal of the two checkoffs receiving the 10 least in contributions over a two-year period.
