- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

TLSB 2189YH (3) 86 rh/nh 1 Section 1. Section 237A.13, subsection 7, paragraph c, Code 2 2015, is amended to read as follows:

3 c. Families with an income of more than one hundred percent 4 but not more than one hundred forty-five eighty-five percent 5 of the federal poverty level whose members, for at least 6 twenty-eight hours per week in the aggregate, are employed 7 or are participating at a satisfactory level in an approved 8 training program or educational program.

## EXPLANATION

10The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with11the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill relates to state child care assistance program 13 eligibility and waiting list guidelines.

14 The state child care assistance program is administered by 15 the department of human services. Based upon the availability 16 of the funding appropriated for state child care assistance 17 for a fiscal year, the department establishes waiting lists 18 for state child care assistance in descending order of 19 prioritization.

20 Under current law, one of the waiting list requirements 21 relates to families with an income of more than 100 percent but 22 not more than 145 percent of the federal poverty level whose 23 members, for at least 28 hours per week in the aggregate, are 24 employed or are participating at a satisfactory level in an 25 approved training program or educational program. The bill 26 increases this waiting list income eligibility limit from 145 27 percent to 185 percent.
