## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the speed limit on the interstate road
- 2 system.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2248

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.285, subsection 5, paragraph a, Code 2 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. Notwithstanding any other speed restrictions, the speed
- 4 limit for all vehicular traffic on fully controlled-access,
- 5 divided, multilaned highways is sixty-five miles per hour.
- 6 However, the speed limit for all vehicular traffic on highways
- 7 that are part of the interstate road system, as defined in
- 8 section 306.3, is seventy miles per hour, except the department
- 9 may establish a speed limit of seventy-five miles per hour on
- 10 highways that are part of the interstate road system on the
- 11 department's own motion or in response to a recommendation
- 12 of a metropolitan or regional planning commission or council
- 13 of governments. The department may establish a speed limit
- 14 of sixty-five miles per hour on certain divided, multilaned
- 15 highways not otherwise described in this paragraph.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 Under current law, the speed limit on interstate highways
- 20 is 70 miles per hour. This bill allows the department of
- 21 transportation (DOT) to establish a speed limit of 75 miles
- 22 per hour on interstate highways on the DOT's own motion or in
- 23 response to a recommendation of a metropolitan or regional
- 24 planning commission or council of governments.
