- 1 An Act modifying penalties for littering.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 455B.364, Code 2015, is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 **455B.364** Penalty.
- 4 Any person violating the provisions of section 455B.363,
- 5 upon conviction, shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor.
- 6 The court, in lieu of or in addition to any other sentence
- 7 imposed, may direct and supervise a labor of litter gathering.
- 8 Notwithstanding section 903.1, any person who violates section
- 9 455.363 shall be fined at least two hundred fifty dollars.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 805.8A, subsection 14, paragraph d, Code
- 11 2015, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 d. Litter and debris violations. For violations under
- 13 sections 321.369 and 321.370, the scheduled fine is seventy two
- 14 hundred fifty dollars.
- 15 Sec. 3. Section 805.8B, subsection 6, paragraph e, Code
- 16 2015, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 e. For violations under section 461A.43, the scheduled fine
- 18 is thirty two hundred fifty dollars.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill increases penalties for littering.
- 23 Under Code section 455B.363, a person shall not discard
- 24 any litter onto or in any water or land of this state. Under
- 25 current law, a person who violates Code section 455B.363 is
- 26 quilty of a simple misdemeanor, and shall be fined at least \$65
- 27 but no more than \$625. The bill provides that a person who
- 28 violates Code section 455B.363 shall be fined at least \$250.
- 29 Under Code sections 321.369 and 321.370, a person shall not
- 30 litter on a highway. Under current law, the scheduled fine for
- 31 violating Code sections 321.369 and 321.370 is \$70, and the
- 32 bill increases the scheduled fine to \$250.
- Under Code section 461A.43, a person shall not litter in
- 34 a state park or preserve. Under current law, the scheduled
- 35 fine for violating Code section 461A.43 is \$30, and the bill

1 increases the scheduled fine to \$250.
