A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the property tax levy imposed by a county
- 2 for flood and erosion control projects and including
- 3 applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 161E.9, Code 2017, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 161E.9 Tax levy.
- 4 The county board of supervisors may annually levy a tax not
- 5 to exceed six and three-fourths cents per thousand dollars
- 6 of assessed value of all agricultural lands taxable property
- 7 in the county, to be used for flood and erosion control,
- 8 including acquisition of land or interests in land, and repair,
- 9 alteration, maintenance, and operation of works of improvement
- 10 on lands under the control or jurisdiction of the county as
- 11 provided in this chapter.
- 12 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to property taxes
- 13 due and payable in fiscal years beginning on or after July 1,
- 14 2018.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 Current Code section 161E.9 authorizes the county board of
- 19 supervisors to levy a property tax not to exceed 6 3/4 cents
- 20 per \$1,000 of assessed value of all agricultural lands in the
- 21 county. Tax revenue from the levy must be used for flood and
- 22 erosion control, including acquisition of land or interests in
- 23 land, and repair, alteration, maintenance, and operation of
- 24 works of improvement on lands under the control or jurisdiction
- 25 of the county as part of a project in cooperation with the
- 26 federal government or a department or agency of the federal
- 27 government.
- 28 This bill strikes language limiting the levy to agricultural
- 29 lands and provides that the property tax is imposed on all
- 30 taxable property in the county.
- 31 The bill applies to property taxes due and payable in fiscal
- 32 years beginning on or after July 1, 2018.
