- Section 1. POLLINATOR STUDY. The department of natural resources shall conduct a one-year study of pollinator species on property managed by the department. The study shall take place at numerous sites managed by the department through all geographic sectors of the state as determined by the department. The study shall examine factors that attract pollinator species and methods to encourage the continued existence or reemergence of pollinator species on property owned by the department. For purposes of this study, pollinator species shall include but not be limited to any species of bird, bee, butterfly, bat, or other animal known to naturally perform pollination activities. The department shall submit a report to the general assembly detailing its findings and recommendations by December 31, 2021.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- This bill requires the department of natural resources to conduct a study investigating factors that attract pollinator species and methods to encourage the continued existence or reemergence of pollinator species on properties managed by the department of natural resources. The study shall be conducted for one year and take place at numerous sites managed by the department through all geographic sectors of the state as determined by the department. The department shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the general assembly by December 31, 2021.
