- 2 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2019, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 For purposes of this subsection section:
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 68A.405, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 6 subparagraph (3), Code 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Published material" means any newspaper, magazine,
- 8 shopper, outdoor advertising facility, poster, direct mailing,
- 9 brochure, internet site, campaign sign, or any other form of
- 10 printed or electronic general public political advertising.
- 11 "Published material" includes television, video, or motion
- 12 picture advertising, live telephone calls, automated telephone
- 13 calls, or text messages.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 Under current law, published material designed to expressly
- 18 advocate the nomination, election, or defeat of a candidate
- 19 for public office or the passage or defeat of a ballot issue
- 20 is required to include an attribution statement indicating
- 21 who is responsible for the published material. This bill
- 22 adds live telephone calls, automated telephone calls, and
- 23 text messages to the definition of "published material". A
- 24 person who violates a provision of Code chapter 68A is subject
- 25 to civil penalties imposed by the Iowa ethics and campaign
- 26 disclosure board, including remedial action, a reprimand, and
- 27 a civil penalty of up to \$2,000. In addition, a person who
- 28 willfully violates a provision of Code chapter 68A is guilty
- 29 of a serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor is punishable
- 30 by confinement for no more than one year and a fine of at least
- 31 \$315 but not more than \$1,875.
