A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to evidence offered to prove past medical
- 2 expenses.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 622.4 Medical expenses.
- 2 Evidence offered to prove past medical expenses shall be
- 3 limited to evidence of the amounts actually paid to satisfy
- 4 the bills that have been satisfied, regardless of the source
- 5 of payment, and evidence of the amounts actually necessary
- 6 to satisfy the bills that have been incurred but not yet
- 7 satisfied. This section does not impose upon any party an
- 8 affirmative duty to seek a reduction in billed charges to which
- 9 the party is not contractually entitled.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 13 This bill relates to evidence offered to prove past medical
- 14 expenses. The bill provides that evidence offered to prove
- 15 such expenses shall be limited to evidence of the amounts that
- 16 were actually paid to satisfy bills that have been satisfied
- 17 and evidence of the amounts necessary to satisfy the bills
- 18 that have not yet been satisfied. The bill does not impose an
- 19 affirmative duty to seek a reduction in billed charges to which
- 20 the party is not contractually entitled.
