A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the eligibility of students enrolled
- 2 in public schools or nonpublic schools in border states
- 3 or in counties that border another state to compete in
- 4 interscholastic athletic activities provided by public
- 5 schools or nonpublic schools in the other state.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 280.13D Interscholastic athletic
 2 activities schools in border states.
- 3 l. a. If a school district or nonpublic school located in
- 4 a county that borders another state cannot form a team for an
- 5 interscholastic athletic activity because not enough students
- 6 have registered to participate, the board of directors of the
- 7 school district or the authorities in charge of the nonpublic
- 8 school may complete an agreement with a non-Iowa public school
- 9 or nonpublic school that borders the county in which the school
- 10 district or nonpublic school is located to provide for the
- 11 eligibility of the non-Iowa students in the interscholastic
- 12 athletic activity provided by the school district or nonpublic 13 school.
- 14 b. A school district or a nonpublic school shall file a
- 15 copy of each agreement completed under this subsection with the
- 16 appropriate organization, as organization is defined in section
- 17 280.13, not later than April 30 of the school year preceding
- 18 the school year in which the agreement takes effect, unless
- 19 an exception is granted by the organization for good cause.
- 20 An agreement completed under this subsection shall be deemed
- 21 approved unless denied by the organization within ten days
- 22 after receipt. An agreement denied by the organization under
- 23 this subsection may be appealed to the state board of education
- 24 under chapter 290.
- 25 2. The board of directors of a school district located in a
- 26 county that borders another state or the authorities in charge
- 27 of a nonpublic school located in a county that borders another
- 28 state may complete an agreement with a non-Iowa public school
- 29 or nonpublic school that borders the county in which the school
- 30 district or nonpublic school is located to provide for the
- 31 eligibility of the Iowa school district's or nonpublic school's
- 32 students in interscholastic athletic activities provided by
- 33 the non-Iowa public school or nonpublic school if the Iowa
- 34 public school or nonpublic school cannot form a team for an
- 35 interscholastic athletic activity because not enough students

1 have registered to participate. 2 **EXPLANATION** The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 3 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 5 This bill relates to the eligibility of students enrolled 6 in public schools or nonpublic schools in border states 7 or in counties that border another state to compete in 8 interscholastic athletic activities provided by public schools 9 or nonpublic schools in the other state. The bill provides that if a school district or a nonpublic 10 11 school located in a county that borders another state cannot 12 form a team for an interscholastic athletic activity because 13 not enough students have registered to participate, the school 14 district or the nonpublic school may complete an agreement 15 with a non-Iowa public school or nonpublic school that borders 16 the county in which the school district or nonpublic school 17 is located to provide for the eligibility of the non-Iowa 18 students in interscholastic athletic activities provided by 19 the school district or nonpublic school. The bill requires 20 school districts and nonpublic schools to file a copy of 21 such agreement with the appropriate organization, as defined 22 in Code section 280.13 (requirements for interscholastic 23 athletic contests and competitions), not later than April 30 24 of the school year preceding the school year in which the 25 agreement takes effect, unless an exception is granted by 26 the organization for good cause. The bill provides that an 27 agreement completed under these provisions shall be deemed 28 approved unless denied by the organization within 10 days after 29 receipt. The bill authorizes school districts and nonpublic 30 schools to appeal a denial by the organization to the state 31 board of education. 32 The bill provides that a school district or a nonpublic 33 school located in a county that borders another state may 34 complete an agreement with a non-Iowa public school or 35 nonpublic school that borders the county in which the school
