A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS IN AID OF THE ASYLUM FOR
FEEBLE-MINDED CHILDREN, AT GLENWOOD.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there is hereby
2 appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, in aid of
3 the asylum for feeble-minded children at Glenwood, the following sum of money for the
4 following purposes :

5	Corridor	\$ 500
6	Barn for cows.....	250
7	Ten cows.....	300
8	Money advanced by Dr. Archibald for land	140
9	Team and buggy.....	375
10	Repairs on old building	1,250
11	For heating buildings	3,000
12	Cistern (1,000 barrels).....	550
13	Sewerage	1,500
14	New furniture, beds and bedding	2,500
15	Grounds for farm and garden.....	3,000
16	Fencing	1,000
17	Laundry and washing machines	1,000
18	School apparatus and books.....	550
19	Salaries.....	7,590
20	Safe	200
21	New building	20,000
22	Steam engine and pump.....	650
23	Water-tank and foundation and fixtures.....	800
24	Pipes, hose, water-closets and plumbing.....	1,500

25 Warrants for this money shall be issued by the auditor of state, as the same may be
26 necessary, upon the order of the president of the board of trustees for said institution.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers
3 published at Des Moines, Iowa.
