

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE IOWA HOSPITAL FOR THE
INSANE, AT INDEPENDENCE.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there is hereby
2 appropriated for the Iowa hospital for the insane, at Independence, out of any money in the
3 state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the following sums, and for the following purposes,
4 to-wit :

5 For finishing and furnishing sections three and four of the south wing of said hospital,
6 twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000).

7 For completing the south wing of hospital, sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000).

8 For distributing sewerage, one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800).

9 For contingent fund, for replacing or repairing boilers, three thousand dollars (\$3,000), or
10 so much thereof as may be necessary.

11 For constructing a well, one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or so much thereof as may be nec-
12 essary.

13 For constructing two cisterns, one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500).

14 For plastering basement, five hundred dollars (\$500).

15 For clothes-wringer and mangle, eight hundred dollars (\$800).

16 For constructing a reservoir, five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

17 For general contingent fund, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

SEC. 2. The several sums hereby appropriated for replacing or repairing boilers, for
2 clothes-wringer and mangle, and for general contingent fund, may be drawn and expended
3 by the board of trustees of said hospital.

SEC. 3. The sum of five hundred dollars, appropriated by chapter 90, laws of the seven-
2 teenth general assembly, for the purpose of repairing road on the south side of farm, may be
3 expended, under the direction of the board of trustees, on the road east of the hospital.

SEC. 4. That not more than forty thousand dollars of the sums appropriated by this act
2 for finishing and furnishing the hospital, shall be drawn from the treasury during the year
3 1880.

SEC. 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be expended in accordance with the
2 provisions of chapter 120, of the laws of the thirteenth general assembly, and the act of
3 which that is amendatory.

SEC. 6. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in
2 force from and after its publication in the *Daily State Register* and *Daily State Leader*, news-
3 papers published in Des Moines, Iowa.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE IOWA HOSPITAL FOR THE

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there is hereby
2 appropriated for the Iowa Hospital for the Insane at Independence, out of any money in the
3 state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the following sums and for the following purposes,
4 to-wit:

5 For finishing and furnishing sections three and four of the south wing of said hospital,
6 twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000).

7 For inclosing section No. 5, sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000).

8 For contingent fund, for replacing or repairing boilers, three thousand dollars (\$3,000),
9 or so much thereof as may be necessary.

10 For constructing a well, one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary.

12 For clothes-wringer and mangle, eight hundred dollars (\$800).

13 For general contingent fund, twenty-two hundred dollars (\$2,200).

SEC. 2. The several sums hereby appropriated for replacing or repairing boilers, for
2 clothes-wringer and mangle and for general contingent fund, may be drawn and expended
3 by the board of trustees of said hospital.

SEC. 3. That not more than twenty-five thousand dollars of the sums appropriated by
2 this act for finishing and furnishing the hospital shall be drawn from the treasury during the
3 year 1880.

SEC. 4. The money appropriated by this act shall be expended in accordance with the
2 provisions of chapter 120 of the laws of the thirteenth general assembly, and the act of which
3 that is amendatory.

SEC. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Daily State Register* and *Daily State Leader*, newspapers
3 published in Des Moines, Iowa.
