A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, TITLE IX OF THE CODE OF 1873, RELATING TO CORPORATIONS OTHER THAN THOSE FOR PECUNIARY PROFIT AND TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN CORPORATE ACTS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That chapter 2, title IX of the Code of 1873, be and is hereby amended by adding the following provisions to section 1091 thereof, viz.: "Provided, that all associations heretofore and hereafter organized for the purposes mentioned in this and in section 1095 following, under and in the manner provided by the provisions of chapter 2, title IX, of the Code of 1873, may endure forever or until dissolved in the manner and as is provided may be done by their respective articles of incorporation and this act shall be considered as applying to all such corporations and their several terms of endurance are hereby extended for the full time herein mentioned without further amendment to or change in their respective articles of incorporation ; and, provided further, that all associations for the establishment of seminaries of learning, churches, lyceums, libraries, lodges of Odd Fellows, Masons, and all other institutions for scientific, religious, missionary, benevolent or charitable purposes, heretofore incorporated under the powers and in the manner provided by the provisions of said chapter 2, title IX, from section 1091 to section 1102, inclusive, of the Code of 1873, be and they are hereby legalized and made valid corporations.
