

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 1112 OF THE CODE, AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR IN RELATION TO COUNTY AND DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES, AND PROVIDING FOR HOLDING FARMERS' INSTITUTES.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That section eleven hundred and twelve of the Code be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Sec. 1112. When any county agricultural society or any district agricultural society, composed of counties not receiving money as herein provided, from the State through a county agricultural society, shall have made their reports to the State Agricultural Society, as provided in the preceding section, and raised during the year any sum of money for actual memberships and have held within the county in which said society is located: between the first day of December and the first day of April preceding, an agricultural institute under the control of said agricultural society, they shall be entitled to an equal sum, not exceeding two hundred dollars, from the State Treasury upon affidavit of the president, secretary or treasurer of said society, that such sum was raised for the legitimate purpose of the society during the current year and that said agricultural institute was held as herein required, said affidavits to be accompanied by the certificate of the State Agricultural Society that they have reported according to law.
