

A BILL
FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE IOWA SOLDIERS HOME
AT MARSHALLTOWN.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the soldier's home at Marshalltown, Iowa, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, the following sums for the following purposes, to-wit: For general repairs and contingent fund the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per annum for the years (1890) and (1891); for hospital building the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000); for new building for boiler room for heating the main building and hospital the sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000); for three cottages and furniture for employes the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500); for additional sewerage twelve hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250); for a passenger elevator and fire escape the sum of six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500); for improvement of grounds and repairing fences including the cemetery the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) annually; for sidewalk from building to city limits the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000); for fire pipes, fire plugs, hose and hose carts for main building and hospital the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the commissioners of said home at such times as may be deemed necessary by said commission, provided that any money unexpended after the completion of the improvement for which the sum is herein appropriated may be used as far as necessary for any other purpose specified in this act.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Des Moines Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
