

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION No. 295 OF THE CODE OF 1873, RELATING TO COUNTY
BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS AND ENACTING A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That section No. 295 of the code of 1873 be, and the same is hereby repealed,
2 and that the following be enacted in lieu thereof:

Section 295. At the general election in each year there shall be at least one supervisor
2 elected in each county who shall continue in office three years, provided that when the board
3 of supervisors consists of three members, such members shall be residents of different town-
4 ships at the time of their election. Provided further, that in any county containing a town-
5 ship having a population of more than fifteen (15,000) thousand inhabitants, in which county
6 the board of supervisors shall have been increased under the provisions of section 299 of the
7 code of 1873 to five members, not more than two of said members may be chosen from the
8 township having the population aforesaid, and if in any such county the board shall have been
9 increased to seven members, then not more than three of said members may be chosen from
10 the township having such population in excess of fifteen (15,000) thousand inhabitants.
