A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A FIRE DEPARTMENT IN CERTAIN
CITIES OF THE SECOND CLASS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That any city of the second class having a population of two thousand or
2 upwards, within this state, may levy a tax of not more than two mills on the dollar, in addi-
3 tion to the maximum tax now authorized by law, for the purpose of maintaining a fire de-
4 partment, and the money so raised shall constitute a fire fund and shall be applied to no
5 other purpose.

SEC. 2. The city council shall provide by ordinance the manner in which disbursements
2 shall be made for the purchase of fire apparatus and services rendered by members of the
3 fire department while engaged at any fire; said bills to be audited and paid in the same
4 manner as other bills, by the city council.
