[HOUSE FILE No. 489.—SCHOOLS.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REQUIRE BOARDS OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS TO ASCERTAIN THE AMOUNT OF SCHOOL FUND BELONGING TO THE COUNTY REMAINING UNLOANED ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH REGULAR SESSION, AND TO HAVE A STATEMENT THEREOF PUBLISHED WITH THE PROCEEDINGS OF SAID BOARD.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby made the duty of all boards of county supervisors of this
2 state, on the first day of each regular session of said boards, to inquire into and ascertain the
3 amount of school fund belonging to the county then remaining idle or unloaned, and to
4 cause a statement of the amount thereof so found to be published with the other proceed-
5 ings of the board.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance is hereby declared to be in force
2 from the date of its publication in the Des Moines Leader and Iowa State Register, news-
3 papers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
