

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF HUXLEY, IN STORY COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, On the eighteenth day of January, 1892, the electors of the independent districts
2 of Fieldberg and Palestine, of the township of Palestine, Story County, Iowa, held an elec-
3 tion, and by unanimous vote did declare the said independent district of Huxley to be an
4 independent school district, having for its territory the south-east quarter of section 22, and
5 the south half of section 23, and the south-west quarter of section 24, and the north-west
6 quarter of section 25, and the north half of section 26, and the north-east quarter of section
7 27, all in township 82, range 24, being the boundaries of said independent district of Huxley;

WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen as to the legality of the organization of said independent
2 district; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That said independent school district of Huxley, in the county of Story and
2 state of Iowa, be, and the same is hereby declared to be fully and legally organized and incor-
3 porated, with the boundaries as set forth in the preamble hereto attached, the same as though
4 all the provisions of the statute regulating the organization of independent school districts
5 had been fully complied with; and the said district is hereby declared to have the lawful
6 powers, rights and privileges that would have belonged to said district had the same been
7 legally organized.

SEC. 2. All the acts of the *defacto* officers of said independent school district of Huxley
2 are hereby confirmed, and are declared to have the same force and effect as though said or-
3 ganization had been fully and legally completed.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect from and after
2 the date of its publication, without expense to the state.
