

A BILL

FOR AN ACT LEGALIZING THE INCORPORATION, ORDINANCES AND THE ACTS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL AND TOWN OFFICERS OF HOSPER, IN THE COUNTY OF SIOUX AND STATE OF IOWA.

WHEREAS, After the incorporation of the town of Hosper, in Sioux county, Iowa, and at the time for
2 the election of its first officers, the notice for said election of officers only called for the election of five
3 councilmen, when it should have been six; and,

4 WHEREAS, Only five councilmen were elected at said election in pursuance of such notice; and,

5 WHEREAS, The five councilmen elected at said election appointed an additional councilman.

6 WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen as to the legality of the organization and the acts of the officers of said
7 incorporated town on account of said errors and informalities; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That the incorporated town of Hosper, in the county of Sioux and state of Iowa, be, and
2 the same is declared to be fully and legally organized and incorporated together with the election of its
3 officers, the same as though all the provisions of the statutes regulating the incorporating of cities and
4 towns and the number and election of its officers had been fully complied with. That all proceedings of
5 the town of Hosper, in Sioux county, Iowa, in relation to the incorporation thereof, all ordinances of the
6 town council of said incorporated town so far as they are not inconsistent with the laws of Iowa, and all
7 acts of the officers of said incorporated town, under the ordinances of said town council, are hereby legalized
8 and made valid, as though the specific requirements of the law had been complied with.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect from and after its publica-
2 tion in the Des Moines *Leader*, a newspaper published at Des Moines, Iowa, and Will Well's Alton *Dem-*
3 *ocrat*, a newspaper published at Alton in Sioux county, Iowa, without expense to the state.
