SENATE FILE No. 96—PUBLIC HEALTH.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE HEALTH OF FEMALE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That it shall be the duty of all employers of females in any merchantile or
2 manufacturing business occupation to provide and maintain suitable seats for the use of such
3 female employees, at or beside the counter or work-bench where employed, and to permit the
4 use of such seats by such employees to such an extent as may be suited to the preservation
5 of their health.

SEC. 2. That any neglect or refusal to comply with section 1 of this act by any employer
2 or employers, shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and on being convicted of such refusal or neg-
3 lect, such employer or employers shall be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five dol-
4 lars (\$25) at the discretion of the court and the costs of the suit.

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the district attorney to prosecute all violations of
2 this act upon the filing of an information by any citizen as required by Section 4661, Chap-
3 ter LII of Miller's Code of Iowa.

SEC. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
