A BILL

ELECTION OF COUNTY RECORDER.

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 589 OF THE CODE IN REFERENCE TO THE ELECTION OF COUNTY RECORDER.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That Section 589, of the Code, be amended as follows: By inserting in the fourth line
2 after the word "sheriff," the words "county recorder," and by striking out of said section after the word
3 "and" in the third line the words "a recorder of deeds."

SEC. 2. All county recorders elected in the year 1890 shall hold their office until the first Monday in
2 January, A. D. 1894, or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Such successors shall be
3 elected in the year 1893 and each odd numbered year thereafter.

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the county recorder of each county to present at the regular January
2 meeting in 1893 of the board of supervisors of his county, a good and sufficient bond, in such penal sum
3 and with such conditions as are now prescribed by law for the official bonds of such recorders, which when
4 approved by said board of supervisors, shall be the official bond of said recorder for the year 1893. In
5 case any county recorder shall fail to furnish such bond as is now by law required, such failure shall create
6 a vacancy in the office for the year 1893 and such vacancy shall thereupon be filled as now provided by
7 law for filling vacancies in said office.
