SENATE FILE No. 231.—JUDICIARY.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO LEGALIZE OFFICIAL ACTION OF C. R. WOOD, A NOTARY PUBLIC OF
HANCOCK COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The said C. R. Wood, a notary public of Hancock county, used his official seal between the
2 date of expiration of one term as notary and the beginning of his next term, under the impression that at
3 the time of thus using his seal, as in the past on such occasions, his commission had been renewed, and
4 the date of the new one, August 5, 1891, showing that at that time it had not been renewed.

Be it enacted, that all of the official acts of said C. R. Wood, by him performed as a notary public in
2 and for Hancock county, after the expiration of his term in the year 1891 and the renewal of the same,
3 August 5, 1891, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid to the same extent as though he had
4 been a qualified notary public at the time of performing said acts.
