## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ACTS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LEE COUNTY, IOWA, IN RELATION TO THE LEVY OF TAXES.

WHEREAS, The board of supervisors of Lee county, Iowa, has been levying and caused to be collected  
2 a tax of four mills on the dollar for county, two mills for the poor and one and one-half mills for insane purposes  
3 annually ever since the year 1876. The whole amount raised by said levies was required for their respec  
4 tive purposes and was economically disbursed; and,

5 WHEREAS, Doubts exist as to the legality of said levies, which it is desirable should be removed and  
6 printed; therefore,

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :*

SECTION 1. That all the acts of the board of supervisors of Lee county, Iowa, in levying and causing  
2 to be collected a tax of four mills for county, two mills for poor and one and one-half mills on the dollar  
3 for insane purposes annually, ever since the year 1876, be, and the same are hereby legalized and made  
4 valid and binding, as full and to the same extent, as if the same were in all respects done in strict con-  
5 formity to the law relating to the subject.
