

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT REPEALING THAT PART OF SECTION 1, CHAPTER 16, OF THE LAWS OF THE TWENTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND SECTION 1, CHAPTER 27, OF THE LAWS OF THE TWENTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY, RELATING TO THE BRIDGE FUND AND ENACTING IN LIEU THEREOF A LAW GIVING THE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES OF THE STATE FULL CONTROL OF THE LEVYING AND EXPENDING OF THE BRIDGE FUND.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That all that part of section 1, chapter 16, of the laws of the Twenty-second General  
2 Assembly, following the word "determined" and commencing with the word "and" in the forty-ninth line  
3 thereof, and all of section 1, chapter 27, of the laws of the Twenty-third General Assembly, be, and the  
4 same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit: The board of supervisors of  
5 each county of the state shall have full control of the levying of the bridge tax and the expending of the  
6 bridge fund in their respective counties, and the levy shall be uniform and equal, and made upon the  
7 assessed value of all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the county, including city and  
8 town property. And it shall be the right and duty of the board of supervisors of each county to use the  
9 bridge fund levied and paid upon the taxable property of their respective counties for the construction of  
10 bridges and approaches thereto, repairing the same and paying bridge bonds and interest thereon, issued  
11 by their respective counties. And the same care and attention shall be given to the building and main-  
12 taining of bridges and the approaches thereto in all parts of the county, including cities and towns. And  
13 all bridge tax heretofore levied in favor of cities and towns, shall be when collected by the county treas-  
14 urer of the county in which such cities may be situated, transferred to the general bridge fund of such  
15 county; *provided*, that this act shall not apply to cities that have issued bridge bonds to the amount of  
16 thirty thousand dollars or now have within their corporate limits a bridge or bridges over three hundred  
17 feet long; and *provided* further, that no contract heretofore made respecting the application of the bridge  
18 tax shall be effected hereby.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
