

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO COMPENSATE H. H. JELLY FOR INJURIES RECEIVED WHILE
IN THE EMPLOY OF THE STATE.

WHEREAS, H. H. Jelly, a citizen of the state of Iowa, being employed as a laborer at
2 the Institution for Feeble Minded Children for the last four or five years in the capacity of
3 fireman and brick-maker at said institution; and

4 WHEREAS, On the 24th day of October, 1894, while in the discharge of his duty in load-
5 ing brick, without any fault or negligence on his part, a portion of the kiln fell, carrying
6 him with it and falling on top of him, inflicting bodily injuries, fracturing his leg so that he
7 is a permanent cripple and unable to perform manual labor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the state treasury, from any
2 moneys not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five thousand dollars, as a partial compensa-
3 tion to the said H. H. Jelly for the permanent injuries received by him while in the employ
4 of the state.
