

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE BETTER EQUIPMENT OF,
AND THAT THE STATE OF IOWA MAY BE SATISFACTORILY REPRESENTED
AND MORE ADVANTAGEOUSLY ADVERTISED BY THE IOWA STATE BAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not
2 otherwise appropriated, the sum of (10,000) ten thousand dollars per annum to the Iowa
3 State Band, that so satisfactorily represented Iowa during its tours, and at the world's
4 fair at Chicago. Such sums to be drawn upon warrants in quarterly installments, pay-
5 able to its band master and founder, Frederick Phinney, or his authorized agent.

6 Such money to be devoted to the improvement and equipment of said band, and through
7 its advertising paper become a satisfactory representative of the state.

SEC. 2. With the view that this band may become self-supporting, it may take part in
2 any private display wherever its services may be demanded; *provided*, however, that on
3 such occasions its services shall be rendered without expense to the state.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect from and
2 after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers
3 published in Des Moines, Iowa.
