

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 13 OF THE LAWS OF IOWA WITH  
REGARD TO THE INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL AT MITCHELLVILLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That section 2702 and section 2703 of the code of Iowa be, and the same are  
2 hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. That section 2704 of the code of Iowa, be and the same is hereby amended  
2 by striking out of the fourth line thereof the word "it" and by inserting in lieu thereof  
3 "the board of control of state institutions."

Sec. 3. That section 2705 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. The superintendent of the Industrial school at Mitchelville shall, on or before  
2 the first day of January of each year, and at any other time when so requested by the board  
3 of control of state institutions, make a report to the said board in writing, stating all his  
4 accounts, attaching thereto copies of all vouchers and documents, shall state the names of  
5 all officers and employes of the said institution, and their salaries, and an estimate of the  
6 value of all the personal property of the state in connection with the said school, and a full  
7 report of the condition of the said institution, the discipline enforced in the school, and  
8 everything connected with the management of the school, and its condition.

Sec. 5. That section 2707 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the words "the board of trustees" in the second line thereof and inserting in  
3 lieu thereof the word "he," and by striking out the sentence commencing in the third line of  
4 the said section with the word "the" and ending in the word "office," in the eighth line  
5 thereof.

Sec. 6. That section 2708 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out of the first line thereof the word "seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the word  
3 "ten," and by inserting in the second line thereof, after the word "mind," and before the word  
4 "shall" the following: "excepting married women, prostitutes, or any girl who is pregnant.

Sec. 7. That section 2709 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 inserting therein between the word "girl" and the word "the" in the third line thereof the  
3 following: "over the age of ten years and under the age of sixteen years."

Sec. 8. That section 2710 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out of the first line thereof the following words “convicted of a crime and,” and by  
3 striking out of the fourth line of the said section the word “trustees” and inserting in lieu  
4 thereof the words “board of control of state institutions.”

Sec. 9. That section 2711 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out of the said section the words “the board of trustees” and inserting in lieu  
3 thereof “the board of control of state institutions.”

Sec. 10. That section 2713 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended  
2 by striking out all of the said section after the word “same” in the second line from  
3 the bottom of the said section.

Sec. 11. That chapter 80 of the laws of the Twenty-seventh General Assembly be, and  
2 the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 12. That section 2708 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby  
2 amended by striking out of the said section the word “majority” in the thirty-  
3 first line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the words “the age of eighteen years.”

Sec. 13. That section 2709 of the code of Iowa, be and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out of the said section the word “majority,” in the eleventh line thereof, and  
3 inserting in lieu thereof the words “eighteen years.”

Sec. 14. That section 2711 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the word “majority,” in the third and eighth lines thereof, and inserting in  
3 lieu thereof in each instance the words “eighteen years.”

Sec. 15. That section 2713 of the code of Iowa be, and the same is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the words in the third line of said section commencing with the word “or” and  
3 ending with the word “necessary.”

Sec. 16. That chapter 8, of title 13 of the code, be amended by adding thereto the fol-  
2 lowing section:

3 Whenever any person committed to the Industrial school at Mitchellville shall become  
4 unruly or shall refuse to obey the rules of the institution, or any reasonable requirement of  
5 the superintendent of the said school, the said superintendent shall report such person so  
6 offending to the board of control of state institutions, and the said board of control shall  
7 investigate the said charges, and if, in their judgment, they deem it to the best interest of  
8 the said school, they may transfer such offending person to the female department of the  
9 penitentiary at Anamosa or to any female reformatory, if one be established in the state of  
10 Iowa, for such a length of time as in their judgment they may deem proper, not exceeding  
11 the time for which such person was committed to the said Industrial school.
