

Joint Resolution

PROPOSING AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF IOWA, RELATIVE TO SUFFRAGE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS REFERENCE AND PUBLICATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the following amendment to the constitution of the state of Iowa be, and
2 the same is hereby proposed:

3 Strike out the word "male," in section one (1), article two (2) of said constitution; and,
4 be it further . . .

5 *Resolved*, that the foregoing proposed amendment to the constitution be, and the same is
6 hereby referred to the legislature to be chosen at the next general election for members of
7 the general assembly, and that the secretary of state cause the same to be published for three
8 months previous to the day of election, as provided by law.
