

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAND, TOMBSTONE, AND ERECTION THEREOF FOR THE PROPER MARKING OF THE GRAVE OF ONE CHARLES SHEPHERD, A SOLDIER WHO SERVED IN THE WAR OF THE REVOLUTION, DIED IN 1845, AND WHO LIES IN AN UNMARKED GRAVE NEAR MILLS-PAUGH'S MILLS, HENRY COUNTY, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not
2 otherwise appropriated a sum not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) to be used for the pur-
3 pose of buying a tract of land not to exceed one acre, also a tombstone and other necessary arti-
4 cles, and other expense incident to the erection of said monument for the proper marking of
5 the grave of one Charles Shepherd, a soldier who served in the war of the revolution, who died
6 in 1845, and now lies in an unmarked grave near Millsbaugh's Mills, Henry county, Iowa.

Sec. 2. The executive council is authorized and directed to carry out the provisions of
2 this act and to expend the money as provided by section one (1) and to draw same from the
3 state treasury in the usual manner.
