

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR (2674) CHAPTER FOUR (4), TITLE XIII (13) OF THE CODE OF IOWA, ALSO SUCH PORTION OF SECTION ONE (1) CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO (152) OF THE ACTS OF THE TWENTY-EIGHTH (28) GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS PROVIDES AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) FOR REPAIRS, GENERAL IMPROVEMENTS, CURRENT EXPENSES AND ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR THE COLLEGE, AND SUCH PORTION OF SECTION ONE (1) CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE (183) OF THE ACTS OF THE TWENTY-NINTH (29) GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS PROVIDES AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000) FOR ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FUND FOR THE COLLEGE; AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR PROVIDING FOR A LEVY OF A SPECIAL TAX OF THREE-TENTHS OF A MILL ON THE DOLLAR UPON THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY OF THE STATE, FOR REPAIRS, GENERAL IMPROVEMENTS, CURRENT EXPENSES, AND SUPPORT, OF THE IOWA STATE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND MECHANIC ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That section two thousand six hundred and seventy-four (2674), chapter four
2 (4), title XIII (13), Code of Iowa, be repealed; also such portion of section one (1), chapter one
3 hundred and fifty-two (152), of the acts of the Twenty-eighth (28) General Assembly as pro-
4 vides for an annual appropriation of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for repairs, general
5 improvements, current expenses and additional support for the College; also such portion of
6 section one (1), chapter one hundred and eighty-three (183), of the acts of the Twenty-ninth

7 (29) General Assembly as provides for an annual appropriation of thirty-five thousand dollars
8 (\$35,000) for additional support fund for the College; the repeal in each case to take effect
9 July 4, 1905.

Sec. 2. That for the purpose of providing for repairs, general improvements, current
2 expenses, and support, of the Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts there shall
3 be levied annually a special tax of three-tenths of a mill on the dollar upon the assessed valu-
4 ation of the taxable property of the state and the proceeds thereof shall be carried into the
5 treasury to the credit of said College. Said levy shall be first made with the levy made for
6 State purposes in the year nineteen hundred and four (1904) and the same levy shall be made
7 annually thereafter. The money realized from such levy for said College shall be held by the
8 Treasurer of the State for the purpose hereinbefore provided and drawn upon requisition of
9 the Board of Trustees. The funds to be realized from the tax levies herein provided before
10 shall not be anticipated by issuing or discounting warrants or other obligations of the State.

Sec. 4. IN EFFECT. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect
2 and be in force from and after its publication in the Register and Leader and Des Moines
3 Daily Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa
