

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE USE OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE CHARITY FUND OF BOULDER LODGE SANATORIUM FOR CONSUMPTIVES AT FT. DODGE, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the use of the trustees of the Charity Fund of Boulder Lodge Sanatorium for consumptives at Ft. Dodge, Iowa, the sum of ten thousand dollars out of the money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the same to be expended, or so much thereof as may be necessary, under the direction of the Board of Control of State Institutions.

Sec. 2. A commission consisting of two members of the Senate, one of whom shall be a practicing physician, and three of the House, who shall be practicing physicians, shall be appointed by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House, whose duty it shall be to gather statistics relative to tuberculosis and its treatment, and especially with regard to the advisability of establishing in Iowa a State Sanatorium for the treatment of that disease, and report its finding to the Thirty-first General Assembly of Iowa.

Sec. 3. No member of the commission shall receive any compensation for services as a member, but the traveling expenses of members in attending meetings of the commission or investigating sanatoria, and other incidental and necessary expenses connected with the work of the commission shall be paid, but the whole amount of said expense shall not exceed the sum of \$1,500.00 in any one year.

Sec. 4. All bills incurred by the commission or by its members under the law and as provided in section three (3) hereof, shall be certified by the president and secretary of the commission to the State Auditor, who shall issue warrants therefor upon the State Treas-

4 urer, and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,500.00 annually, for two years, to carry
5 into effect the provisions of this section out of any money not otherwise appropriated, and
6 any balance not expended in the first year may be added by the commission to the expendi-
7 tures of the ensuing year. All warrants and bills for the expense of the secretary and mem-
8 bers of the commission, and all bills for expenditures by the commission, shall be itemized
9 and verified and be audited and allowed by the Executive Council before being paid.

Sec. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Register and Leader and the Des Moines Daily Capital,
3 newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
