

A BILL

FOR AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF POLICEMEN AT CERTAIN
STATE INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That upon the application and recommendation of the Board of Control of
2 State Institutions the Governor shall commission any number of employes of any institution
3 under the control of the Board, not exceeding three (3), to be designated by the chief execu-
4 tive officer, to be special policemen thereof; and such officer or officers shall take an oath of
5 office and shall have power to protect the property of such institution, to suppress riots, dis-
6 turbances and breaches of the peace, and to enforce all laws for the preservation of good order
7 and may, upon view or information, without warrant, arrest any person trespassing upon the
8 grounds or destroying the property of such institution, or violating any of the existing laws of
9 the State, and bring such person so offending before the mayor or any justice of the peace
10 within such township, to be dealt with according to law. This act shall not be construed to
11 authorize any additional employes in any institution, or any increase of compensation to any
12 employe so designated.
