

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION FORTY-ONE-A (41-A) OF THE SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, THE SAME BEING ALSO CHAPTER TWO (2) OF THE ACTS OF THE TWENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, RELATING TO THE STATUTES, AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That Section forty-one-a (41-a) of chapter three (3) of the Supplement to the Code, the same being also chapter two (2) of the acts of the Twenty-seventh General Assembly, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Every act passed in amendment, modification or repeal of a law shall in its title and in the body of the act itself, refer to the law so amended, modified or repealed, as follows:

1. One which amends, modifies or repeals any part of the Code shall refer to the section, chapter and title of the part or parts of the Code amended, modified or repealed.

2. One which amends, modifies or repeals any part of the Supplement to the Code shall refer to the section, chapter and title of the part or parts of the Supplement to the Code, as numbered therein, so amended, modified or repealed.

3. One which amends or repeals any part, or all, of any act of the General Assembly not contained in the Code, or the Supplement to the Code, shall refer to the chapter and number of the General Assembly which passed the act so amended, modified or repealed.

4. If such reference be omitted in the title, the Secretary of State shall in preparing such act for publication supply the omission.

5. Whenever reference is made to any section, chapter or title of any law, as hereinbefore provided, the number of the same shall be expressed in words, followed by the figures in parentheses.

Sec. 2. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Daily Register and Leader and the Daily Capital, news-
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
