# A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING IT A MISDEMEANOR TO WILFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY OBSTRUCT THE LIGHTS OF A DWELLING HOUSE OF AN ADJOINING OWNER BY THE ERECTION OR MAINTENANCE OF WALLS OF LUMBER OR OTHER MATERIALS AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully and maliciously erect or  
2 maintain any obstruction on the line of his own premises that shall have for its object the shut-  
3 ting off or obscuring the light to the windows of a dwelling house of a person on any adjoining  
4 land.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a mis-  
2 demeanor and be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding  
3 thirty (30) days, or by a fine not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars and the said obstruction  
4 may be declared a nuisance and abated accordingly.
