

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO INDEMNIFY CHARLES H. TRIBBY FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY SEW-
AGE FROM THE STATE HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE, AT MOUNT PLEASANT, IA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not
2 otherwise appropriated, so much as shall be found due to Charles H. Tribby for payment of
3 damages sustained, if any, by him in consequence of the flow of sewage from the Hospital
4 for the Insane at Mount Pleasant, Iowa, upon land rented by him during the year 1903, pro-
5 vided that the sum appropriated under this act shall not exceed one thousand and fifty dollars
6 (\$1,050).

Sec. 2. The damages sustained, if any, by said Charles H. Tribby, shall be ascertained by
2 the Board of Control of State Institutions of Iowa, and shall be paid on a voucher approved
3 by said Board of Control in the same manner that the ordinary expenses of said institutions
4 are paid; and if the amount found to be due by said board is accepted by said Charles H.
5 Tribby, it shall have the force and effect of full compensation for all damages sustained by
6 him from such flow of sewage.

Sec. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after the date of its publication in the Register and Leader and the Des Moines Daily
3 Capital, two newspapers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.
