

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PAY SUNDRY PERSONS NAMED IN THIS BILL, FOR MATERIAL AND LABOR FURNISHED BY THEM IN THE ERECTION OF THE MEDICAL HOSPITAL OF THE IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY, ERECTED IN EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN (1897).

WHEREAS, The persons named in section one (1) of this bill furnished material and labor for
 2 the erection of the medical hospital, erected by the Iowa State University in 1897, and for
 3 which they have not been paid, by reason of the fact that the contract price was insufficient
 4 to pay the cost of the material and labor furnished for said building, and the contractor,
 5 James Howie, was, and is insolvent; and

6 WHEREAS, There is due and unpaid to said persons the respective amounts named in said
 7 section one, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated, out of any funds in the state treasury
 2 not otherwise appropriated, the sum of six thousand, three hundred seventy-seven dollars and
 3 forty-nine cents, (\$6,377.49). Said sum to be paid as follows:

12 The state auditor is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants to each of the above
 13 named persons and companies for the respective amounts above stated.

Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
 2 from and after its publication in the Register and Leader, and Des Moines Daily Capital,
 3 newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa, without expense to the state.
