

A BILL

FOR AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2000) TO BE PAID TO MRS. JOHN STEIN, IN SETTLEMENT OF ALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE OF IOWA BY REASON OF THE DEATH OF JOHN STEIN WHO WAS KILLED BY A FALLING SCAFFOLD AT THE FORT MADISON PENITENTIARY WHILE WORKING UNDER THE ORDERS OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF CONSTRUCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) as payment in full of all claims against the state of Iowa, arising from the death of John Stein, who was killed on the 4th day of August, 1905, by a falling scaffold at the Fort Madison Penitentiary, and while working under the instructions and orders of the superintendent of construction.

Section 2. The sum of money hereby appropriated shall be paid to Mrs. John Stein.

Section 3. The auditor of the State of Iowa is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the state treasury in favor of Mrs. John Stein the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000). The said Mrs. John Stein shall file with the auditor of the State a receipt acknowledging for payment of all claims for damages against the State sustained by her, by reason of death of John Stein.

Section 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance will take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Register and Leader, and Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
