

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE IOWA STATE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND MECHANIC ARTS, THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Iowa State College of Agriculture and  
2 Mechanic Arts out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of  
3 one hundred twenty-eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$128,500) annually hereafter for  
4 support fund; and for the support of the Experiment Station the sum of twenty-five thousand  
5 dollars (\$25,000) annually hereafter. Said sums to be paid in quarterly installments on order  
6 of the trustees. The first installment to be payable June 30, 1906.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State University out of any money in the State  
2 treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the support of said University, the sum of one hun-  
3 dred eighty-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$185,500) annually hereafter. Said sum to be  
4 paid in quarterly installments on order of the Board of Regents of said University. The first  
5 installment to be payable June 30, 1906.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Normal School at Cedar Falls out of any  
2 money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated for payment of teachers the sum of  
3 seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$72,500) annually hereafter, and for Contingent  
4 and Repairs the sum of thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000) annually hereafter, each of which  
5 shall be paid quarterly on order of the Board of Trustees. The first installment to be payable  
6 June 30, 1906.

Sec. 4. The permanent annual appropriations herein provided for shall take the place of,  
2 and be in lieu of, all other permanent annual appropriations heretofore made to the Iowa  
3 State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts, the State University and the State Normal  
4 School and the sums appropriated shall be paid in quarterly installments on the order of the  
5 Trustees, the Board of Regents and the Board of Trustees of their respective institutions.  
6 The first installment to be payable June 30, 1906.

Sec. 5. Nothing in this act shall be construed to, in any manner, affect any existing appro-  
2 priations until June 30, 1906, at which time any sums of money drawn by either of the  
3 above named institutions shall be drawn under the provisions of this act and not of any

4 former provisions.

Sec. 6. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force  
2 from and after the date of its publication in the Des Moines Daily Capital and the Register  
3 and Leader, newspapers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.
