

A BILL

FOR AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF EDITH MAY EATON, MINOR CHILD OF J. N. EATON, WHO WAS KILLED WHILE WORKING ON THE STATE HISTORICAL BUILDING OF THE STATE OF IOWA.

WHEREAS, J. N. Eaton, while employed in the construction of the State Historical Building was, on account of the negligence of his superiors in not providing sufficient scaffolding, thrown or fell from the top of said building to the basement underneath, receiving injuries from which he died within a few hours; and,

WHEREAS, The said Eaton left no property or means of support for his family; and,

WHEREAS, Mary K. Eaton, wife of said J. N. Eaton, has since died leaving one minor child Edith May Eaton, aged five years, the daughter of the said J. N. Eaton and Mary K. Eaton, who is now without means of support and without relatives having sufficient means to support her; therefore,

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there be paid to the guardian of said Edith May Eaton, out of any funds
2 in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the
3 support and maintenance of said minor child.
