

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE DOLLARS AND NINETY CENTS (\$251.90) TO JOHN M. WYRICK TO REIMBURSE HIM FOR EXPENSES AND SERVICES IN THE EXTRADITION OF A FUGITIVE FROM JUSTICE.

WHEREAS, John M. Wyrick, now a resident of Polk County, was, August 29, 1894, appointed by Frank D. Jackson, Governor of Iowa, as agent to demand of the Governor of Arkansas, a requisition for the arrest of one Charles Fossitt, as a fugitive from justice, and

WHEREAS, The said John M. Wyrick presented the said requisition to the Governor of Arkansas, and arrested and returned to the State of Iowa, on warrant issued in pursuance thereof, the said Charles Fossitt, and

WHEREAS, The said Charles Fossitt was held to the grand jury of Polk County, Iowa, on the charge upon which said requisition was issued, and the said charge was dismissed by the grand jury of Polk County, not by any fault or neglect on the part of those interested in the prosecution, and

WHEREAS, The expense incurred, and fees for serving the said requisition and warrant, were the sum of two hundred fifty-one dollars and ninety cents (\$251.90), and the said John M. Wyrick has not been repaid any part of the same, therefore,

*Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury the sum of  
2 two hundred fifty-one dollars and ninety cents (\$251.90) to be paid to the said John M. Wyr-  
3 ick, and the Auditor of the State of Iowa is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the  
4 State treasury in the sum of two hundred fifty-one dollars and ninety cents (\$251.90) in favor  
5 of John M. Wyrick, when said John M. Wyrick shall file with the Auditor of the State of  
6 Iowa a receipt in full for all claims held by him against the State growing out of the extradi-  
7 tion of Charles Fossitt.
