

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE FIRST AND SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICTS OF THE STATE OF IOWA AND THE DISTRICT AS THEN CONSTITUTED TO BE KNOWN AS THE SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE OF IOWA, AND CHANGING THE NAME OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE OF IOWA.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the First Judicial District of the State of Iowa and the Second Judicial
2 District of the State of Iowa as now constituted be and they are hereby consolidated and
3 made one judicial district to be known hereafter as the Second Judicial District of the State of
4 Iowa, and shall consist of and embrace the following named counties, to-wit: Lee, Van Buren,
5 Jefferson, Davis, Wapello, Monroe, Appanoose and Lucas.

SEC. 2. That there shall be five district judges in the Second Judicial District of the State
2 of Iowa as provided for by section 1 of this act.

SEC. 3. That the present judge of the First Judicial District of the State of Iowa and the
2 four judges of the Second Judicial District of the State of Iowa be and the same are hereby
3 declared to be the judges of the Second Judicial District of the State of Iowa as now consti-
4 tuted and established by section 1 of this act, and shall continue as judges until the expiration
5 of the term of office for which the said several judges were elected or until their successors are
6 elected and qualified.

SEC. 4. That there shall be elected by the qualified electors of the Second Judicial District
2 of the State of Iowa as defined in this act, at the general election in the year 1911, and every
3 four years thereafter, five district judges, who shall receive the same compensation as other
4 district judges, and said district judges shall enter upon the discharge of their duties of their
5 office on the first day of January, 1912, and shall hold their office until their successors are
6 elected and qualified.

SEC. 5. The district courts shall be held in the Second Judicial District of the State of Iowa
2 as defined by this act as heretofore provided by law, and shall have full jurisdiction in all the
3 counties comprising said district as herein defined.

SEC. 6. That the orders now made, or which may be made prior to July 4, 1909, by the

2 judges of the First and Second Judicial Districts of the State of Iowa, as said districts have
3 heretofore existed, in their respective districts, assigning the terms of court in their respec-
4 tive districts for the period as now provided by law for duration of such assignments of terms
5 of court shall be in force and govern the time of holding the terms of court in the different
6 counties of the Second Judicial District of the State of Iowa as defined by this act for the
7 period as now provided by law for duration of such assignments of terms of court.

SEC. 7. That the name of the Twentieth Judicial District of the State of Iowa be and the
2 same is hereby changed to, and said district shall hereafter be known and designated as the
3 First Judicial District of the State of Iowa.

SEC. 8. That all acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act and provisions be and the
2 same are hereby repealed.
