# A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL PARAGRAPH SIXTEEN (16) OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED ELEVEN (511) OF THE SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1907, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER THIRTY-SIX (36) OF THE ACTS OF THE THIRTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY RELATING TO THE BOARDING AND LODGING OF PRISONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Paragraph Sixteen (16) of Section Five Hundred Eleven (511) of the Supplement to the Code 1907, as amended by Chapter Thirty-six (36) of the Acts of the Thirty-third General Assembly is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

“16. For boarding prisoners, a compensation of twelve and one-half cents for each meal, and not to exceed three meals in twenty-four consecutive hours, and for each night’s lodging the sum of twelve and one-half cents, provided that in counties having a population of Fifty thousand or over, the Board of Supervisors may fix the compensation of the sheriff for boarding and lodging prisoners, at a rate not exceeding the above, or in counties of such population the Board of Supervisors, instead of allowing compensation to the sheriff for such boarding and lodging, may purchase and furnish at the expense of the county, all necessary food and sustenance for the prisoners, and it shall be the duty of the sheriff upon request of the Board, to appoint a jailor who shall be a deputy sheriff and give bond and serve as such. It shall be the duty of such jailor to properly care and account for all provisions furnished by the said Board and to properly cook, prepare and serve the same to said prisoners, for which service he shall receive a salary, to be paid by the county, of One Hundred Dollars per month and house rent in the jail. The Board may, in addition, allow such jailor the necessary food, fuel and lights for himself and family. The said Board shall have power to appoint such jailor in case the sheriff neglects or refuses to make the appointment within ten days after request.”

Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in force and effect from and after its publication in the Register and Leader and The Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
