A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT AND CONTINGENT FUNDS FOR THE IOWA SOLDIERS' HOME, IOWA SOLDIERS' ORPHAN'S HOME, SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF, INSTITUTION FOR FEEBLEMINDED CHILDREN, SANATORIUM FOR THE TREATMENT OF TUBERCULOSIS, INDUSTRIAL SCHOOLS, STATE HOSPITALS, PENITENTIARY, REFORMATORY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAND, AND FOR A STATE INSTITUTION FOR EPILEPTICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one million six hundred twenty-two thousand seven hundred five (\$1,622,705.00) dollars, for the construction, repair, improvement and contingent funds for the Iowa soldiers' home, Iowa soldiers' orphans' home, school for the deaf, institution for feeble-minded children, sanatorium for the treatment of tuberculosis, industrial schools, state hospitals, penitentiary and reformatory, for the purchase of land for one or more of said institutions, and to provide a site and to commence the construction of buildings for a state institution for epileptics. in sums as hereinafter specified.

Sec. 2. All money appropriated by this act shall be drawn from the state treasury and expended in the manner provided by chapter eleven-b (11-b) of title XIII of the supplement to the code, 1907. Any balance remaining of any appropriation after the object for which it was made has been accomplished may be expended in the discretion of the board of control of state institutions for any purpose connected with the institution for which the appropriation was made, and the board of control shall report within five days after the convening of the next general assembly the amount transferred from each fund as provided in this section and the amount of unexpended balances in the state treasury December 31, 1914.

Sec. 3. Of the appropriations made by this act the Iowa soldiers' home at Marshalltown shall receive sums as follows:

Sec. 17. Of the appropriations made by this act, the sum of one hundred thousand (\$100,-
2 000.00) dollars is for the purchase of land for the use of one or more of the state institutions
3 hereinbefore named. The board of control of state institutions shall designate the institutions
4 for which land is to be purchased and the amount to be expended for each, and the amounts so
5 determined shall be drawn from the state treasury on vouchers duly executed for each purchase
6 and approved by the chief executive officer of the institution for which the purchase was made
7 and by said board of control.

Sec. 18. Of the appropriations made by this act, the sum of two hundred thousand (\$200,000.00) dollars is for the purchase of land, the preparation of building sites, and the commencement of buildings and the procuring of equipment for a state institution for epileptics.

Sec. 19. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Register and Leader and the Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
