

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW AS IT APPEARS IN SECTION 2575-A 9, CHAPTER 16-A, SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1913, RELATING TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR BACTERIOLOGICAL LABORATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That section twenty-five hundred and seventy-five-a nine (2575-a 9), chapter sixteen-a (16-a) of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof; there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of more perfectly equipping the present bacteriological laboratory at the State University, and for the purpose of enabling it to perform the duties hereby imposed, and to provide it with the necessary apparatus and assistants to render the same effective, to pay the salaries of these assistants and other employes, and to employ a special assistant bacteriologist and chemist who shall be subject to be called to the aid of the state board of health in the furtherance of its epidemiological work and the making of water analyses, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) annually, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for proper equipment, necessary apparatus, and the salaries and miscellaneous expenses, including stationery and postage, which may be incurred in maintaining said laboratory and performing the duties required therein by the provisions of this act. The appropriation hereby provided shall be expended in the manner provided in section twenty-five hundred sixty-four-a (2564-a) of the supplement to the code, 1913.
