

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT (298), SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1913, RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF DEPUTY CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURT AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That section two hundred ninety-eight (298), supplement of the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof: "Appointment, Compensation, Qualification. The clerk, with the consent of the board of supervisors, may, when necessary, appoint a deputy, or employ a clerk, or clerks, who shall not be a county officer. A certificate of such appointment and of the revocation thereof, when made, shall be filed with the county auditor. Deputy clerks of the district court shall receive an annual compensation for all services the following: In counties having a population of less than fifteen thousand, seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars. In counties having a population of fifteen thousand and less than twenty thousand, eight hundred (\$800.00) dollars. In counties having a population of twenty thousand and less than twenty-five thousand, nine hundred (\$900.00) dollars. In counties having a population of twenty-five thousand and less than thirty thousand, one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars. In counties having a population of thirty thousand and less than thirty-five thousand, one thousand one hundred (\$1,100.00) dollars. In counties having a population of thirty-five thousand and less than forty thousand, twelve hundred (\$1,200.00) dollars for first deputy and one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars for second deputy. In counties having a population of forty thousand and less than forty-five thousand, first deputy one thousand three hundred (\$1,300.00) dollars, second deputy one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars, and such clerk hire as may be necessary, the salary of such clerk or clerks to be fixed by the board of supervisors at the time of the appointment, providing, however, that the total compensation of such deputies and clerks shall not exceed four thousand (\$4,000.00) dollars. In counties having a population of forty-five thousand and less than fifty thousand, one thousand four hundred (\$1,400.00) dollars for the first deputy and one thousand two hundred (\$1,200.00) dollars for the second deputy, and such clerk hire as may be necessary, the salary of such clerk or clerks to be fixed by the board of supervisors, at the time of the appointment, providing, however, that the total compensation of such deputies and clerks shall not exceed the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars. In counties having a population of fifty thousand or over, the salaries of the first deputy shall be sixteen hundred (\$1,600.00) dollars, and that of the second deputy fourteen

27 hundred (\$1,400.00) dollars, and such clerk hire as may be necessary, the salary of such clerk or
28 clerks to be fixed by the board of supervisors, at the time of the appointment, the total salaries of
29 such deputies and clerks shall not exceed eight thousand (\$8,000.00) dollars. All of the above
30 to be paid out of the county treasury in equal monthly installments.

31 The deputy shall take the same oath as his principal, to be endorsed on the certificate of his
32 appointment, and may perform the duties of his principal.
