

A BILL

FOR AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW AS IT APPEARS IN SECTIONS TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-a (2794-a), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-b (2794-b), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-c (2794-c), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-d (2794-d), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-e (2794-e), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-f (2794-f), TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR-g (2794-g), RELATING TO CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, EXTENDING STATE AID TO SCHOOL TOWNSHIPS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the law as it appears in section two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-a (2794-a), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-b (2794-b), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-c (2794-c), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-d (2794-d), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-e (2794-e), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-f (2794-f), two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-g (2794-g), be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto as section two thousand seven hundred ninety-four-h (2794-h), the following:

“In any case where a township has a single school organization without subdistricts and as such school township maintains and operates a central school, which in its appointments and courses of study would, if a consolidated independent school district, entitle such school to receive the state aid provided for consolidated independent schools, such school township shall be given such state aid notwithstanding the maintenance by such school organization of other schools within its territory; providing, however, that children advanced beyond eighth grade work shall not be received in said other schools but shall attend said central school, and providing further that transportation be furnished all children of school age desiring to attend said central school.”
