

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW AS IT APPEARS IN SECTION TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED FORTY (2540) SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1907, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE (153) ACTS OF THE THIRTY-THIRD (33) GENERAL ASSEMBLY, RELATING TO THE USE OF TROT LINES, AND TO THE TIME DURING WHICH ONE MAY TAKE FISH FROM THE WATERS OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the law as it appears in section twenty-five hundred forty (2540) of the supplement to the code, 1907, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

1. By striking out the word "May" in the thirteenth line of said section and substituting therefor the word "April".

2. By striking out the words "extending not more than half" in the fourteenth (14th) line of said section and substituting therefor the words "such line may extend all the".
